O'Neill reviewed the Report through the first 9 months of the fiscal year. He pointed out that cash balances are very strong. This is partly due to the ARPA funding from the federal government but also due to strong sales tax growth and the village holding the line on budgeted expenses.

8 Miscellaneous

O'Neill discussed the new hourly engineering rates for Brad Brink. It was pointed out that Brad has been the Village Engineer since 1993 and his new rate of 5% higher, from \$138 to \$145 per hour than his current rate is less than what we were charged in 2013.
