

**MINUTES  
FOR THE PUBLIC HEARING  
OF THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
OF THE VILLAGE OF ORLAND HILLS, ILLINOIS  
FOR DECEMBER 1, 2010**

President Hastings called the hearing to order at 7:46 p.m.

Administrator Daly called the roll with the following results. Present: President Hastings, Trustees: O'Neill, Roti, Janachowski, Morrison, Hastings and Administrator Daly, Clerk Burke (7:49pm). Absent: none. Others present were Building Commissioner Ennesser, Police Chief Thomas G. Scully, Asst. PW Dir. Craig Schmidt, Tribune Reporter Barb Dargis.

Administrator Daly announced that the purpose of the hearing was to provide public input to the Annual Tax Levy Ordinance, being considered by the Village Board at the Regular Board Meeting, later this evening.

Administrator Daly explained that the Ordinance had been on file in the Clerk's Office since November 5, 2010. He further explained that proper legal notice had been published in the Daily Southtown/Star newspaper on November 19, 2010. He then explained that the Tax Levy determination was made on October 15, 2010 and that the Finance Committee reviewed the appropriations and approved recommendation, thereof, on November 9, 2010, at the regular monthly Committee Meeting.

Administrator Daly then explained that the amount proposed to be levied is 9.25% greater than the prior year; however, it is estimated to create a slight decrease in the rate of 3.4%. Mr. Daly stated that a public hearing is required by state law. It has been the practice, since 1993, by the Kyle Hastings Administration to hold such public hearings, in order to affect openness and honesty in the Village Government, whether or not a hearing is required by law.

President Hastings asked for input from the Village Board, and none was offered.

President Hastings asked for input from the Public at 7:50 PM. Tribune Reporter, Barb Dargis, asked questions regarding the levy amount, current year tax rate and effect on an average homeowners tax bill.

President Hastings asked for input from the Public at 7:55 PM and none was offered.

President Hastings asked for input from the Public at 7:59 PM and none was offered.

There being no further business, President Hastings requested support of a motion to adjourn the hearing at 8:00pm. Motion by Trustee Morrison, Seconded by Trustee Hastings. Ayes: Trustees: O'Neill, Roti, Janachowski, Morrison and Hastings Nays: None. Absent: None.
