- 2.) Discussed:
 - a.) Main car manufacturers no longer making police sedans and future vehicles needing to be SUV's. To date, the four older police fleet vehicles have already depleted the majority of our department's vehicle maintenance budget.
 - b.) The four recruits currently in the part-time police academy will begin gun school next week and upon completion, transition into patrol for preliminary field training. In addition, their tentative graduation date is scheduled for January 25, 2025.
 - c.) Trustee Roti's inquiry about the Sergeant's exam results and if we were looking to promote.
 - d.) Trustee Roti's inquiry about the implementation of a Police Corporal rank.
 - e.) Trustee Roti's inquiry about how civil service employees receive raises and the current police administrative clerk position pay.
