- 2.) Update on the 2022 Fall Recreation Programs.

Recreation Director Bilina updated the Committee on the upcoming Fall Programs which begin the week of September 26th. Some of the Fall Programs which are currently in session include Preschool, Women's Volleyball League, Co-ed 16" Friday League and the 16" Men's Sunday League. The Recreation Department is currently reserving and confirming fall gym usage with outside associations.

- 3.) Update on the 29th Annual 1 Mile Jr. / 5K Open Turkey Trot Race
 Recreation Director Bilina updated the Committee on the upcoming Turkey Trot Race. The race
 registration is being held online on the recreation website and at the Community Center. The race is
 advertised on the following race and websites sites: Chicago Southland Convention and Visitor's
 Bureau, Run Race, Running in the USA, Race Thread, Cardinal Joseph Bernardin School and at
 Fernway School. The Recreation Department also began contact calling on previous sponsors.
- 4.) Update on the Lake Lorin Burn.

Recreation Director Bilina informed the Committee on the Lake Lorin Burn. The burn will be held in late October or early November. The Davis Resource Group has acquired the IEPA Permit. Notifications will be sent out one week before the burn. Three weeks before the burn, a notice will be posted on the Village and Recreation Department Websites. Cardinal Joseph Bernardin School, Christian Hills School, Fernway School, School District's #135 & #140 will be notified. Davis Resource Group was informed about the Lake Lorin Construction Project.

5.) Miscellaneous

- a. The concession stand roof repair was completed.
- b. The Tribute Tree Memorial was remodeled. The memorial was cleaned. New plaques and new glass were installed.
- c. At the next Village Board Meeting, there will be a vote on the approval of the Big Tent Events Contract and the approval of the Mad Bomber Fireworks Contract.
- d. The Volleyball Officials cost has escalated from the previous \$20.00 per match to current \$36.00 a match. The Recreation Department will be raising the winter entry fee \$20 per team. The fee will increase from the previous \$320.00 per team to the current \$340.00 per team fee.
