6. Other- Miscellaneous:

Committee asked about the robot mower and are concerned it could get stolen. It was reassured that if it was taken for our location the GPS would cut off and the robot would not work. It was noted this could be in violation of the CBA and needs to be looked into. Committee would like to see a potential drone footage of the robot cutting Kelly Park. It was asked how much they cost and it was noted it varies based on the size of the mower.

Assistant Director Rediger discussed how Andrew's Construction class reached out to see if we would be interested in having them build us a few picnic tables. The consensus was yes to build two new ones.

Assistant Director Kaslewicz brought up Ballet 5:8 and how they would like to do a "Live" Story time program (like a Disney style class) it would be \$250 for the class. They also would like to offer other classes including adult. This would be a 6 week class and would be a contracted program at a cost of \$45/hr. Committee liked this idea but would like a little more detail.

Assistant Director Kaslewicz noted Chicagoland Indoor Soccer has partnered with Chicago Fire and would like to know if we could do temporary lining this season. Which would make the games go better Committee agreed to try a test area first before applying a "line." It was also noted they would be paying for the paint and an upcharge for clean up.
